Universal Reference Publications, an imprint of Grey House Publishing, is proud to announce the publication of the Sixteenth Edition of *America's Top-Rated Cities: A Statistical Handbook*. This brand new set offers current, comprehensive statistical information in one easy-to-use source on 100 cities that have been cited as the best for business and living in the United States. Conveniently arranged by city, this four-volume set allows readers to see, at a glance, a concise social, business, economic, demographic and environmental profile of each city, including brief evaluative comments. There are four volumes in the set, each covering a specific region of the United States: Southern, Western, Central and Eastern.

To offer a more varied representation of American cities, this sixteenth edition includes no more than one city from each metro area, with the exception of Minneapolis/St. Paul and Tampa/St. Petersburg. As a result, we have 6 brand new cities, 3 of which were added due to such high ratings and not necessarily meeting the population criteria of 100,000. The 6 new cities are:

Each city chapter is divided into three major sections: Background (updated with significant news in both business and living environments), Rankings (enhanced with survey results from over 200 sources), and Statistical Tables (updated with new data plus many new data points). Every chapter is followed by Comparative Statistics, which arrange the data across 73 tables. The six appendices and maps of each region will make finding specific or comparative data easy.

BACKGROUND ESSAY: Each of the 100 city chapters begins with an informative background essay that combines history with current events. Our revision process updates these narratives to reflect changes that have occurred in the city in the past year. They touch on the city's environment, politics, employment, cultural offerings, climate, and often include interesting trivia.

RANKINGS INFORMATION: This section has again grown tremendously over the previous edition. Each city has rankings from a possible 238 books, articles, and reports. For easy reference, these Rankings are categorized into 11 topics like: Business/ Finance, Health/ Environment, Seniors/ Retirement, Sports/ Recreation, Dating/ Romance, and Culture/ Performing Arts. The Rankings are presented in an easy-to-read, bulleted format and include results from both annual surveys and one-shot studies. This 2008 edition also includes many new Rankings, such as:

STATISTICAL TABLES: As with the Rankings, the Statistical Tables have been increased and enhanced over the years. Each city chapter now includes 97 tables – 52 in BUSINESS and 45 in LIVING. Ninety Percent of statistical data has been updated. Among the many topics already listed in this work, a new topic this year is **Identity Theft Consumer Complaints**, and expanded topics include **Housing Vacancy Rates** and **Distribution of Physicians**.
