- Government Agencies, arranged by state with key contact information
- Publications, with nearly 1,400 listings organized into 17 subject areas ranging from Administration to Technology in Education
- School Supplies, featuring 7 categories, including Audio Visual Materials, Electronic Equipment, and Sports & Playground Equipment

Section II: Statistics and Rankings, offers 145 tables and charts arranged into 9 chapters, such as: Adult Education, Elementary & Secondary Education, International Comparisons of Education, Learning Resources & Technology, and, new to this 2007/08 edition, Canadian Education Statistics. Using the most recent data available, this section's chapters present information on degree attainment, enrollment, drop-outs, faculty revenues, expenditures and much more, all clearly organized and many divided into state-by-state rankings.

The third and final section of the 2007/08 *Educators Resource Directory* includes three indices:

- Entry & Publisher Name Index, an alphabetized guide to publications included in Chapter 8: Publications, including both listed resource and publisher.

- Subject Index, an alphabetical list of NCLB-relevant listings, organized by certification areas (for example: Civic & Government, Foreign Language, History, Science, Special Education)
