Part One, “A History of Evolution” contains five chapters that all deal with topics in early evolution ideas and the beginning of Charles Darwin. Sections include the conflict before, during and after Charles Darwin; the beginning of Darwinism and its roots in America; and finally the rise of Creationism, Intelligent Design, and Darwinian Religion in America.

Part Two, “Evolution Matures” contains seven chapters that go deeper into the evolutionary front and focus on the specifics and arguments of Darwinism. Sections include Darwinism and Genetics, Two New Sciences at War, Human Sociobiology, Evolutionary Development, and New Evolutionary Theories.

Part Three, “Documents” is divided into twelve sections, each devoted to the twelve chapters in Part One or Two. Each section contains several supporting documents that really drive home the importance and main ideas of the particular topic.

Part Four, “Biographies” provides details on the philosophers, scientists and forward-thinkers that had written before, during, and after the time of Charles Darwin. This important section, new to this edition, provides a “Who’s Who” of the key players in the main text.

Part Five, “Appendixes”, includes the following sections:

- A Chronology of Events: Organizes key events from the 1500s to the present time.
- Glossary: Provides A-to-Z definitions of the topics and ideas in the main text.
- Credits and Permissions to all Illustrations and Documents.

February 2009, will mark the 200-year anniversary of Charles Darwin’s birth and a beginning of one of the oldest and engaging discussions for centuries to follow.
