Here is an overview of each section:

**Disorders:** consists of 21 chapters dealing with broad categories of mental health issues written in layman's terms on specific syndromes within a general category, such as Social Anxiety Disorder within the Anxiety Disorders chapter. Following the descriptions are specific resources relevant to the disorder, including Associations, Books, Government Agencies, Periodicals, Pamphlets, Support Groups, Hot Lines, Resource Centers, Audio & Video Tapes, and Web Sites.

**Associations, Organizations, Government Agencies:** displays contact information on more than 1,000 National Associations, and Federal and State Agencies that offer general mental health services and support for patients and their families.

**Professional Support & Services:** provides resources that support the many different professionals in the mental health field. Included are specific chapters on Accreditation and Quality Assurance, Associations, Books, Conferences and Meetings, Periodicals, Training and Recruitment, Audio and Video Tapes, Web Sites, and Workbooks and Manuals.

**Publishers:** lists major publishers of books and magazines that focus on health care or mental health issues. This material is suitable for both professionals in the mental health industry as well as patients and their network community.

**Facilities:** displays major facilities and hospitals, arranged by state, which provide treatment for persons with mental health disorders.

**Clinical Management:** shows products and services that support the Clinical Management aspect of the mental health industry, including Directories and Databases, Management Companies, and Information Services, which provide patient and medical data, as well as marketing information.

**Pharmaceuticals Companies:** offers complete contact information on the pharmaceutical companies that manufacture drugs to treat mental health disorders. This data is presented in two ways: alphabetically by company name and drug name. NEW to this section is an Appendix of generic medications, and the brand names they replace.

The Complete Mental Health Directory also contains three separate indexes. **Disorder Index** lists entries by disorders and disorder categories. **Entry Index** is an alphabetical list of all entries. **Geographic Index** lists entries by state.

The information in this revised edition is crucial for those suffering from a mental condition and their support network, including professionals who diagnose and treat mental disorders. It combines, in a single volume, disorder descriptions written in clear, layman's terms, and a wide variety of resources.
