Each country chapter is divided into three parts. The first is an alphabetical, independently written **Country Overview**, covering current political and economic events on an unbiased level. Most chapters also include a **Map** with indicators for key places, and **Key Facts** about the featured country such as official country name, ruling parties, language spoken, population, etc. **Key Indicators** such as population, GNP, foreign debt, exchange rate, etc. are all charted over five years. The last part is each country's **Risk Assessment** that evaluates the politics, economy and general stability of the featured country and the region it is a part of. This is the kind of information that makes *Nations of the World* a proven house reference work.

The second part is a **Country Profile**, which includes detailed historical information, political structure and parties, and a thorough look at population, labor market, media, trade, industry, agriculture and energy.

The final part of each country chapter is a **Business Directory**, which provides contact numbers and websites for hotels, travel information and chambers of commerce.

The **World Overview** section follows the country profiles, and offers an expertly written narrative on the political and economic climate of each of the five regions covered; Africa, The Americas, Asia, Europe, and the Middle East. This narrative includes key indicators, currencies and a map of the region. The final part is the **Global Overview**, which summarizes and integrates the information from each Country Overview and each region covered by the World Overview into a comprehensive look at the status and developments of countries worldwide. Like the individual country chapters, these regional chapters include Maps, political and economic climates, Currencies, and Key Indicators.

Nations of the World is also available as a CD-ROM, as a companion to the print directory. Each country entry from the print edition is reproduced in Adobe .PDF format for easy searching and to give the user the ability to print specific entries.
