As the fracturing of society into polarized camps has contributed to violence and destruction, public opinion has shifted on what and who should be included within the parameters of domestic violence, a shift that is carefully considered in the unpacking of these tragic episodes.

Chapters in this volume explore a variety of relevant topics, including:

Each chapter starts with a brief **Introduction**, **List of Topics Covered**, and the source document or documents discussed in the chapter. The text of the chapter relates the source documents to their historical context, and details contemporary public opinion. Most source documents are reprinted in their entirety and are clearly distinguished by a shaded title bar. Photos and other images enhance the text, and sidebars provide an additional perspective on the time period being discussed. Pull quotes and other visual elements increase accessibility. Each chapter ends with a brief **Conclusion**, thoughtful **Discussion Questions**, and a list of **Works Used**.

This exciting series offers a wide range of insights into long-standing issues that Americans are most concerned about, and those that have encouraged vigorous debate among politicians and citizens at large. Using carefully-chosen original documents that cover a wide time span, *Opinions Throughout History* weaves a thoughtful and easy-to-understand analysis of how public opinion is formed and evolves, starting the discussion at an historical, seminal moment, and ending with where we stand today.
