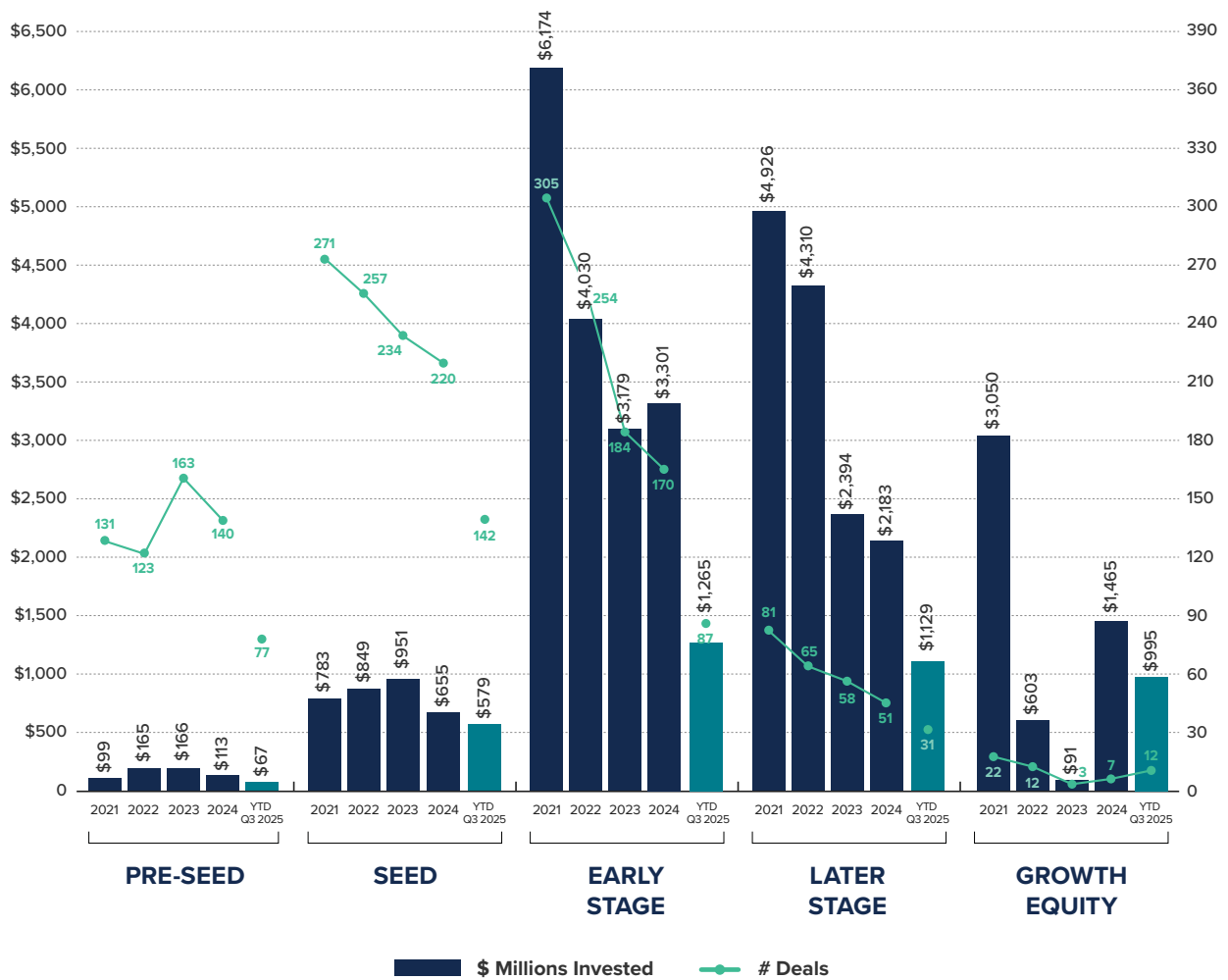
User Guide

Shown below is a fictitious listing illustrating the kind of information that is or might be included in an entry. Each numbered item is described on the following page.

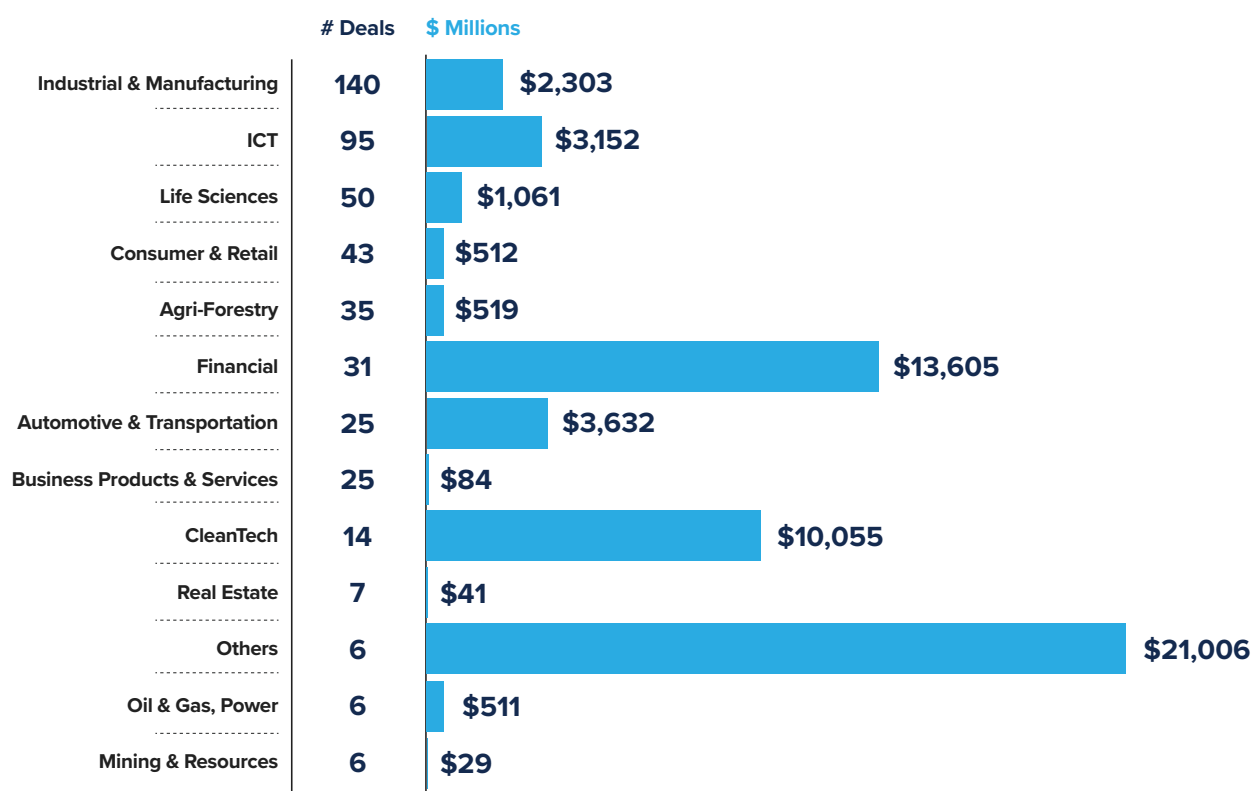

▶ VC YEAR-OVER-YEAR STAGE BREAKDOWN (2021-YTD Q3 2025)



Venture investment activity across stages showed a clear slowdown in year-to-date Q3 2025 compared to 2024. Seed-stage investments remained one of the more resilient areas, with total dollars invested just 12% below full-year 2024 levels despite fewer deals. Growth-stage activity was another exception, with deal volume up 71% year-over-year, signaling increased investor focus on later-stage opportunities within the venture cycle.

Financial and Cleantech stood out in the first three quarters of 2025, driven by major privatizations such as [Toronto-based CI Financial Corp](#) for [\\$12.1B](#) and [Longueuil-based Innergex Renewable Energy Inc](#) for [\\$10B](#). While these mega-deals brought attention to less prominent sectors, the overall sector distribution remained consistent with trends observed in H1. The Industrial and Manufacturing sector led in deal volume, representing 29% of all transactions (140 deals) and \$2.3B in capital invested. The Information, Communication and Technology (ICT) sector followed with 95 deals totaling \$3.2B, while Life Sciences ranked third with 50 deals securing nearly \$1.1B.
