Introduction

Hudson's Washington News Media Contacts, first published more than 50 years ago, continues to offer current, comprehensive data on international journalists and news outlets. Much has changed in how news is researched, reported, and accessed. What has not changed is the fact that the Washington D.C. metro area still has the largest concentration of journalists and news outlets in the world.

This 2018 edition of *Washington News Media Contacts* is an indispensable key to those news media contacts based in our nation's capital. As news outlets continue to merge, fold, and reinvent themselves, this work is an ideal resource for public relations and marketing professionals, journalists, association officials, political consultants, lobbyists, and anyone interested in getting their story heard in the Washington arena.

With over 3,000 news organizations and their holdings, and more than 4,000 key media contacts, this edition is arranged in the following sections:

- **News Services:** Includes General News, Specialized News, Photo Services, and City Wires.
- **Newspapers with D.C. Bureaus:** Newspapers that are HQ elsewhere, but have news bureaus in D.C. These listings are divided into General News and Specialized News.
- **Newspapers Headquartered in the D.C. Metro Area:** Separated by General and Specialized News, these are HQ in D.C. proper, or nearby Maryland and Virginia.
- **Foreign News:** Includes both News Services and Newspapers, with country/city of origin, that are based in other countries, but maintain a news bureau in the D.C. Metro Area.
- **Syndicates and Columnists:** Major syndicates whose columnists operate primarily in the D.C. Metro Area.
- **Radio & TV Stations:** Includes Guest Programs; Stations HQ elsewhere, with bureaus in D.C.; Stations HQ in the D.C. Metro Area; and Foreign Stations HQ with bureaus in D.C.

The detailed Table of Contents and the User's Guide navigate the 20 sub-categories, plus five indexes provide further help in locating exactly the place or person you are looking for:

- **Entry Name Index** – alphabetical listing of all main headings in all sections
- **Geographic Index/Foreign Media** – country/city guide to all foreign media with a presence in D.C.
- **Personnel Index** – listing by last name of all key contacts in all sections
- **Magazine Subject Index** – includes 75 categories, from Advertising to Urban Affairs

Washington News Media Contacts will save time as you either search for news specialists interested in your story, or field story requests as a member of the media. The organization and arrangement of information is designed to pinpoint precisely the right person at the right media outlet.
