#### Company Name

Legal name of a firm, the title by which a formally organized or incorporated firm is known as a legal entity or artificial-person. Shown on the certificate of incorporation (firm's 'birth certificate'), it must be displayed clearly at the firm's legal or registered office, and disclosed on all formal documents such as agreements, checks, and official stationery. Also known as corporate name.

#### MARKET

#### Stock Ticker Symbol

An arrangement of characters (usually letters) representing a particular security listed on an exchange or otherwise traded publicly. When a company issues securities to the public marketplace, it selects an available ticker symbol for its securities which investors use to place trade orders. Every listed security has a unique ticker symbol, facilitating the vast array of trade orders that flow through the financial markets every day.

#### Traded On /Exchange

The stock exchange on which the company is listed. The core function of a stock exchange is to ensure fair and orderly trading, as well as efficient dissemination of price information. Exchanges such as: NYSE (New York Stock Exchange), AMEX (American Stock Exchange), NNM (NASDAQ National Market), and NASQ (NASDAQ Small Cap) give companies, governments and other groups a platform to sell securities to the investing public. NASDAQ is abbreviated as NAS throughout the guide. The exchanges listed in this guide include:

## Sector

An industry or market sharing common characteristics. Investors use sectors to place stocks and other investments into categories like technology, health care, energy, utilities and telecommunications. Each sector has unique characteristics and a different risk profile.

## RATINGS

### Overall Rating

The Weiss rating measured on a scale from A to E based on each stock's performance and risk. See the preceding section, "What Our Ratings Mean," for an explanation of each letter grade rating.

### Buy-Hold-Sell Recommendation

Weiss Ratings' opinion of investment action based on a Weiss rating. We recommend buying stocks rated A and B, holding C rated stocks, and selling D and E.

### Reward Rating

Primarily based on a stock's total return to shareholders over the trailing five years and, based on sales, net income, earnings trends and anticipated dividends, its prospects for future returns. Additionally, based on the stock's current price, other important ratios are factored in. Based on proprietary modeling the individual components of the risk and reward ratings are calculated and weighted and the final rating is generated.

### Risk Rating

Primarily based on the level of volatility in the stock's daily, monthly and quarterly returns and on the company's financial stability. Stocks with very stable returns are considered less risky and receive a higher risk rating. Stocks with greater volatility are considered riskier, and will receive a lower risk rating. Companies with poor financial stability are considered riskier investments than those that are financially stable.

### Recent Upgrade/Downgrade

An "Up" or "Down" indicates that the Weiss Investment Rating has changed since the publication of the last print edition. If a stock has had a rating change since December 31, 2017, the change is identified with an "Up" or "Down."

## STOCK PRICES

### Stock Price

The price at which a stock is traded on a regular trading day. Stock prices in this guide are listed as of March 31, 2018.

### 52-Week High

The highest price that a stock has achieved during the previous 52 weeks.

### 52-Week Low

The lowest price that a stock has achieved during the previous 52 weeks.

## BETA

### 3-Year Beta

A three year measure of volatility, or systematic risk, of a security in comparison to the market as a whole. A beta of less than 1 means that the security will be less volatile than the market, a beta larger than 1 means more volatility. Beta value cannot be calculated if less than 24 months of pricing is available.

## RATINGS FACTORS

### Growth

Evaluates each stock based on components including sales growth, change in cash flow and measures of growth in earnings.

### Efficiency

Screens for operational efficiency when the price of a stock is in line with the cost it takes to provide them.

### Solvency

Measures each stock by traditional balance sheet quality and solvency ratios including debt-to-equity and financial strength.

### Volatility

Evaluates the gain/loss performance of each stock over various timeframes by measuring profit potential compared to downside risk.

### Dividend

Measures each stock by its dividend-paying ability to reward stocks with higher total return potential.

### Total Return

Measures the value an investor earns from a security over a specific period when all dividends are reinvested.

## TOTAL RETURNS %

### 3-Month Total Return

The rate of return on an investment over a period of three months that includes interest, capital gains, dividends and distributions realized.

### 6-Month Total Return

The rate of return on an investment over a period of six months that includes interest, capital gains, dividends and distributions realized.

**1-Year Total Return**

The rate of return on an investment over a period of one year that includes interest, capital gains, dividends and distributions realized.

**3-Year Total Return**

The rate of return on an investment over a period of three years that includes interest, capital gains, dividends and distributions realized.

**DIVIDEND/YIELD****Dividend \$ (TTM)**

A dividend is defined as a payment made by a corporation to its shareholders. Usually these payouts are made in cash (cash dividends), but sometimes companies will also distribute stock dividends, whereby additional stock shares are distributed to shareholders. This is a TTM figure (trailing twelve months), which is a representation of a company's financial performance over the most recent 12 months. TTM uses the latest available financial data from a company's interim, quarterly or annual reports.

**Dividend Yield (TTM)**

Dividends paid out each year relative to the share price. Expressed as a percentage and measures how much cash flow an investor is getting for each invested dollar. This is a TTM figure (trailing twelve months), which is a representation of a company's financial performance over the most recent 12 months. TTM uses the latest available financial data from a company's interim, quarterly or annual reports.

**SIZE****Market Capitalization (Market Cap) (\$MIL)**

A term used by the investment community to identify companies based on their market capitalization value. Values are displayed in millions.

**Enterprise Value (\$MIL)**

A measure of a company's total value, often used as a more comprehensive alternative to market capitalization (see Market Capitalization). It includes the company's debt in its calculation and is very important in takeover valuations. Note: Banks do not have enterprise value mainly due to a large variety of the outstanding debt. Values are displayed in millions.

**REVENUE & INCOME****Revenue (\$MIL)**

The amount of money a company receives from its normal business activities, usually from the sale of goods and services to customers.

**Revenue Growth %**

Annual percentage growth in a company's revenue.

**Net Income (\$MIL)**

The net profit or loss recorded by a company. This figure includes the company's operating profit (income from lending, investing, and fees less interest and overhead expenses) as well as non-operating items such as capital gains on the sale of securities, income taxes, and extraordinary items. Values are displayed in millions.

**EARNINGS****Earnings Per Share (Earnings/Share)**

The amount of a company's profit that can be allocated to one share of its stock and does not include dilutive effects on convertibles.

**Earnings Per Share (EPS) Growth**

The percentage change in earnings per share over time. It helps investors to identify the stocks that are increasing or decreasing in profitability. This is a TTM figure (trailing twelve months), which is a representation of a company's financial performance over the most recent 12 months. TTM uses the latest available financial data from a company's interim, quarterly or annual reports.

**EFFECTIVENESS****Cash from Operations (\$MIL)**

Cash flow generated by a company's normal business operations. It indicates whether a company is able to produce positive cash flow to maintain and grow its operations. Values are displayed in millions.

**Return on Assets %**

The ratio of net income for the year as a percentage of average assets. This ratio, known as ROA, is the most commonly used benchmark for profitability since it measures the company's return on investment in a format that is easily comparable with other companies. This is a TTM figure (trailing twelve months), which is a representation of a company's financial performance over the most recent 12 months. TTM uses the latest available financial data from a company's interim, quarterly or annual reports.

**Return on Equity %**

The ratio of net income for the year as a percentage of average equity. This ratio, known as ROE, is commonly used by a company's shareholders as a measure of their return on investment. This is a TTM figure (trailing twelve months), which is a representation of a company's financial performance over the most recent 12 months. TTM uses the latest available financial data from a company's interim, quarterly or annual reports.

## VALUATION

### **Price/Earnings (P/E) TTM**

A ratio that measures the value of a company by comparing its current share price to its earnings per share. A high P/E ratio suggests that investors are expecting higher earnings growth. This is a TTM figure (trailing twelve months), which is a representation of a company's financial performance over the most recent 12 months. TTM uses the latest available financial data from a company's interim, quarterly or annual reports.

### **Price/Sales (P/S) TTM**

A ratio that measures value placed on each dollar of a company's sales or revenues. Generally, a stock with lower P/S ratio is a better investment since the investor pays less for each unit of sales. This is a TTM figure (trailing twelve months), which is a representation of a company's financial performance over the most recent 12 months. TTM uses the latest available financial data from a company's interim, quarterly or annual reports.

### **Price/Book (P/B) Q**

Price to book ratio compares a stock's market daily value to its quarterly book value. This ratio indicates how much shareholders are paying for the net assets of a company and answers the question: how many times a company's stock is trading per share compared to the company's book value per share. A lower P/B could mean that the stock is undervalued and may have a potential for future growth, however, other valuation measures should be considered before investing. Generally, a P/B ratio of 1.0 or less is viewed as good. This is a quarterly figure.
